**What Is a Christian?** (1 for each student)

### GAME

#### ELEPHANT, RHINO, AND RABBIT

The players sit in a tight circle with “It” in the middle. “It” points to someone in the circle and says either *elephant*, *rhino*, or *rabbit*. The person that “It” points to must either put his hands behind his back for the *rabbit*, or put his hands in a fist in front of each other in front of his nose for the *elephant*, or he must put both fists on his nose with the two index fingers pointing upward for the *rhino*. The two people on either side of the player pointed to must put an open hand facing “It” to the first player’s head for *elephant*. For *rhino* they must put a fist to the person’s head. For *rabbit* they must put a fist to his head with one finger pointing upward. All of this must be done before the count of 10. If any one of the three people fail to do his part, he then becomes “It.” *K. David Oldfield*

- **Ephesians 4:32:** Don’t be rough; be tender.
- **2 Corinthians 1:3-4:** Don’t pity yourself; comfort others.
- **Ephesians 5:21:** Don’t be stubborn; submit.
- **1 Thessalonians 4:11-12:** Learn to be quiet and mind your own business.
